

Reading Endorsement  
(K-12, Revised 2006)

Twenty (20) semester credit hours in the area of reading including a minimum of fifteen (15) semester credit hours distributed among each of the following areas: Foundations of Reading or Developmental Reading; Reading in the Content Area: Literature for Youth; Psycholinguistics or Language Development; and Corrective/Diagnostic/Remedial Reading. To obtain a Reading K-12 endorsement, applicants holding a Secondary Certificate must complete an elementary methods course.
